Suggested Walk Plans

Walk One

START from Colchester North Station.
Take a TRAIN or bus service 753 to Bures.
WALK to Stoke-by-Nayland 8 1/2 miles.
BUS back to Colchester. Service 84.

NB: There is no Sunday service.

Walk Two

START from Colchester North Station.
Take BUS 84 Colchester to Nayland.
WALK to Cattawade 11 miles.
Return by TRAIN from Manningtree Station to Colchester.

Walk Three

START from Colchester.
Get BUS 93 to Stratford St Mary.
WALK to Cattawade 5 1/2 miles.
Return from Manningtree Station by TRAIN.

Alternatively, return to Ipswich from Cattawade Slip Road A137, BUS 96.

Walk Four

START from Colchester.
TRAIN or BUS service 753 to Bures.
WALK to Manningtree Station 19 1/2 miles.
TRAIN back to Colchester.

TRAVEL TIPS

Walking time

Allow about 2 miles per hour, but add on time if you want to make use of any of the excellent pubs and refreshment places in villages along the route. Please park considerably if you are planning a 'park-ride walk back to your car' itinerary. Better still, do your bit for the environment and the rural economy by leaving your car at home and use public transport.

Direct Path between Flatford and Manningtree

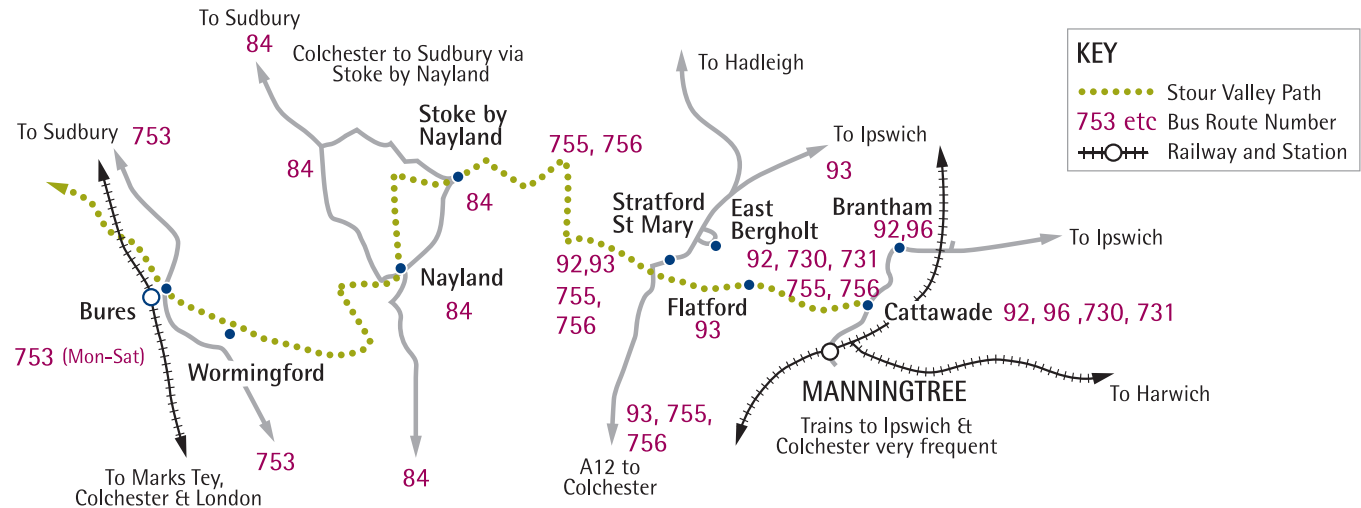
There is a direct riverside path from Flatford to Manningtree Station which has the advantage of avoiding the walk along the B1070/A137 from Cattawade. However, this route doesn't pass the site of John Constable's "Haywain" painting, for which a short diversion will be necessary.

Buses

Distances from Bures can be reduced by using buses to Wormingford: Bus service 753 Monday to Saturday. There is no service on a Sunday. Buses are unlikely to stop to pick up or set down at intermediate stops unless the driver is asked to do so.

Trains

Trains make scheduled stops as advertised. The journey between Sudbury and Bures only takes 7 minutes, so on this journey it is advisable to find the conductor as soon as you get on! There are direct train services from Manningtree Station to Harwich, Colchester, Chelmsford, London and Ipswich. These trains also run on Sundays.

18.5	CATTAWADE Picnic Site and Slip Road Bus Stop (A137) (Manningtree Rail Station 1 mile)
